Public Notice Related to Campus Turnaround Plan
February 19, 2016

Campus: East Austin College Prep Secondary School (MLK Campus)

The East Austin College Prep Secondary School (MLK Campus) has been rated Improvement Required for two consecutive years based on not meeting Index 4 of the state accountability system. In the 2014-2015 school year, for Index 1 (Student Achievement), the campus exceeded the target by 8%; for Index 2 (Student Progress), the campus exceeded the target by 12%; and for Index 3 (Closing Performance Gaps), the campus exceeded the target by 5%. For Index 4 (Postsecondary Readiness), the campus fell short of the target by 3%. Index 4 is comprised of 4 indicators: STAAR Postsecondary Readiness, Graduation Rate, Recommended High School Program and Distinguished Achievement Program Graduates and Postsecondary Readiness for Graduates. Since we have not had a graduating class, we have only been able to be rated for the STAAR Postsecondary indicator. The STAAR Postsecondary indicator is measured by all students who are achieving at the standards set for the 2021-2022 school year for at least 2 STAAR assessments they take. The target is 21% for the campus. The target requires that at least 21% of the students on the campus must meet the 2021-2022 school year passing standards. The campus is working diligently with all students to ensure that they are achieving at higher levels.

As a result of being rated Improvement Required for two consecutive years, the campus is required to create a Campus Turnaround Plan for implementation in the 2016-2017 and 2017-2018 school years. Parents and the community have the opportunity to provide input in the development of the plan. Parent and community input will be solicited from February 19, 2016 through March 25, 2016.
